STALLION SERVICE CONTRACT
FOR FROZEN SEMEN

To the stallion named Click on Clay Joe Cocker For Ever R.D.

for the 2008 breeding season and subject to the following terms and conditions of this contract.

Embryo Transplants are prohibited without prior written consent of the Farm pursuant to a fully executed embryo transfer agreement. The Purchaser may not substitute another mare without prior consent of the Farm.

THE FEES: This contract is for the purchase of frozen semen. Saturnia Stables, LLC will ship three doses per cycle of frozen semen at Purchaser's expense . All shipments will be made only to the address of a licensed veterinarian. Each shipment will contain the correct amount of straws required for each breeding dose. There will be a maximum of 2 cycles, 3 doses per cycle shipped, per contract, per breeding season. This breeding contract is sold on a Live Foal Guarantee provided the said stallion is alive and fit to breed. As used herein the phrase "Live Foal Guarantee" shall be as hereafter defined.

The total breeding fee is \$1,500.00. A non-refundable booking fee of \$500.00 is due with the return of this contract. The balance of the fee is due before the semen is shipped.

All shipping costs are the responsibility of the purchaser. A \$750.00 deposit must be paid in advance for the shipping container. This can be made either by Check or MasterCard/Visa. Any loss or damage to the container will be the responsibility of the Purchaser. Loss or damage will be deducted from the deposit. The shipping container must be back within 10 days in accordance with Select Breeders Service requirements. Failure to return the shipping container by the anticipated due date printed on the frozen semen tracking report will result in a late fee of \$50.00 per day or forfeiture of the container deposit.



The shipping charges can be paid on Purchaser's Federal Express Account or charged to a MasterCard/Visa account. In lieu of a credit card Purchaser may send \$_____ that handling and shipping fees will be deducted from. This will include the shipping and a prepaid return shipment label for the container.

No frozen semen will be shipped until all fees are paid.

CONDITIONS: The Purchaser understands that Saturnia Stables LLC reserves the right to refuse any contract for breeding at its own discretion and that this contract is non-assignable. A copy of the mare's registration papers and pedigree are to be returned with this contract. The semen that is shipped by Saturnia Stables, LLC or its veterinarian must be administered by a veterinarian with considerable experience in frozen semen reproduction.

Stallion service will be provided only to healthy mares, in sound breeding condition as determined by an acceptable veterinarian. Mare owner must provide a veterinary certificate and current uterine culture, taken when the mare is in heat and submitted to a recognized laboratory showing the mare to be in good breeding condition and free from infection. The veterinarian must also certify the mare's immunization for rhino pneumonitis and equine herpes type I have been kept current.

The Stallion has been tested and is EVA Negative.

The collection and preparation of the frozen semen has been completed by our veterinarian.

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE "LFG": The Live Foal Guarantee shall be conditioned upon compliance by Purchaser of all conditions set forth in this contract. The Live Foal Guarantee shall be fully satisfied upon the birth of a live foal that will stand and nurse alone unassisted.

The Live Foal Guarantee is valid only if the Purchaser has properly maintained the health of the mare, and verifies the mare's pregnancy, loss, stillbirth or foal's death by notifying the stallion owner within 48 hours of the foal's death and then, providing Saturnia Stables, LLC with an original signed veterinary certification on the veterinarian's own practice letterhead clearly stating the name of the mare, date of the loss pregnancy, stillborn or newborn foal death within 10 days of the discovery of the mare's pregnancy lost. Upon submission of the foregoing veterinary certification, the Live Foal Guarantee shall thereafter remain in effect for the following breeding season solely by the shipment of semen in such year. This contract is deemed fulfilled upon the birth of a live foal as herein defined or the failure of the mare to produce a live foal following two consecutive breeding seasons of the shipment of semen pursuant to this contract. Except for the Live Foal Guarantee, which is not a warranty, but only a right to receive additional semen under the named conditions, FARM MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WITH RESPECT TO THE SEMEN INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.



The Mare Breeding Passport is to be completed by the receiving licensed veterinarian and returned to Saturnia Stables LLC after the final pregnancy check.

SWITCHING TO FRESH SEMEN

If the mare identified in the contract is not in foal after 2 cycles and at the discretion of the stallion owner management there is the option to switch for one cycle to fresh collected semen with live foal guarantee. Prior to this the breeding, condition of the mare will need to be analyzed following the determination of non pregnancy status after the last cycle bred with frozen semen.

Please notify stallion owner as there will be a booking fee of \$200.00 and collection fee of \$300.00.

The shipping container deposit will be \$350 and will also need to be returned undamaged and clean within 7 days or \$25.00/day late fee assessed. This option will have to be arranged closely with the stallion owner and shipments provided at the discretion of the stallion owner. Preceding any shipment the veterinarian will need to send a letter containing the following:

The Mare has been bred at least 2 different heat cycles, using 3 doses of the frozen semen.

The breeding condition of the mare including uterine culture, and cytology results, trans rectal palpation, vaginal speculum findings and ultrasound.

Treatments used on the mare including uterine flushes and hormones.

The mare is considered sound for breeding.

Should the stallion die or become unfit for breeding prior to the breeding of this mare, this contract shall become null and void.

The parties agree that the terms and conditions stated herein set forth the entire agreement of parties and this agreement cannot be amended except by written agreement of both parties.
